Applications are invited from suitably qualified secondary school teachers to mark JCE and MSCE examinations.

1. JUNIOR CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION (JCE) MARKERS Requirements

- Diploma holders must have a minimum of 5 years teaching experience in the subject they are applying to mark
- Degree holders must have a minimum of 3 years teaching experience in the subject they are applying to mark
- Must be well knowledgeable in the subject they are applying to mark

2. MALAWI SCHOOL CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION (MSCE) MARKERS Requirements

- Diploma holders must have a minimum of 5 years teaching experience in the subject they are applying to mark
- Degree holders must have a minimum of 3 years teaching experience in the subject they are applying to mark
- Must be well knowledgeable in the subject they are applying to mark

- Age and sex
- Academic and professional qualifications
- Subject interested to mark
